

General conditions for lodging service

- I. Lodging service is provided only for students who attend 20 or more hours per week in the school.
- II. Once student end their relationship with the school, they must vacate their accommodations.
- III. Students are not permitted to offer lodging service to others.
- IV. All payments must be done only in the school; any payment made directly to the family/owner will end the student's relationship with the school.
- V. The lodging service is billed weekly; we (families and school) do not accept payments for less than seven days, even if students leave the house early.
- VI. Your weekly cycle begins the day that you arrive at the home, even if you arrive at night.
- VII. On Sundays, holidays and days off, meals are not offered, although some families may choose to invite students if a friendship has formed.
- VIII. The only reasons for changing the assigned home are:
 - Continuous and deliberate refusal or inability to provide the agreed-to services to the student.
 - Verified danger due to the internal conditions in the house.

We understand that contact with a new culture and society can be overwhelming; however, please try to adapt to your new surroundings as much as possible, and respect cultural differences.

HOUSE RULES

- 1 Use Spanish as much as you can; this is the goal of staying in a family home.
- 2 No smoking inside the rooms or common spaces.
- 3 Don't slam the doors.
- 4 Quiet hours will be in effect after 22:00-other students or family members need to sleep
- 5 Please conserve water and electricity as much as possible to enable us to keep our prices low.
- 6 Parties, beers, alcohol or drugs are not permitted.
- 7 Local visitors are not allowed.
- 8 Students must sleep in the assigned room, sharing rooms are not permitted.
- 9 Objects damaged must be paid for or repaired.
- 10 Please let the family know in advance if you are unable to attend a meal.
- 11 Behave properly, be respectful and do not use profane language
- 12 You are responsible for the keys of your home; if you lose them you will be charged for the replacement of both the lock and the key.
